

Bring your ideas to Kyiv Legal Empowerment Practical Program (Kyiv LEPP) **to solve the problem in the field of access to justice.**

KyivLEPP is the international educational course of [Ukrainian Access to Justice School of Practice](#). The course uses design-thinking methodology, and it's aimed to develop human-oriented solutions in the field of A2J



Who may participate? People with the idea of solving a certain problem in the field of access to justice in their country/city, national teams who represent different institutions or communities working in the field, namely:

- Paralegals, mediators, social workers, activists.
- Representatives of vulnerable communities.
- Leaders of local communities.
- State and non-state legal aid providers, advocates, legal clinics' students, teachers).
- Representatives of Ministries and State Agencies.

KYIV LEPP-2020 will be held on **November, 23-25, 27, 30** remotely in Zoom. The course lasts 5 days, every day for three hours with small breaks (time: 9:00 ET/13:00 GMT). **The deadline to apply is October 18**

The topic of KYIV LEPP 2020 is **ROLE OF (NON)LAWYERS IN INCLUSIVE JUSTICE ECOSYSTEM**

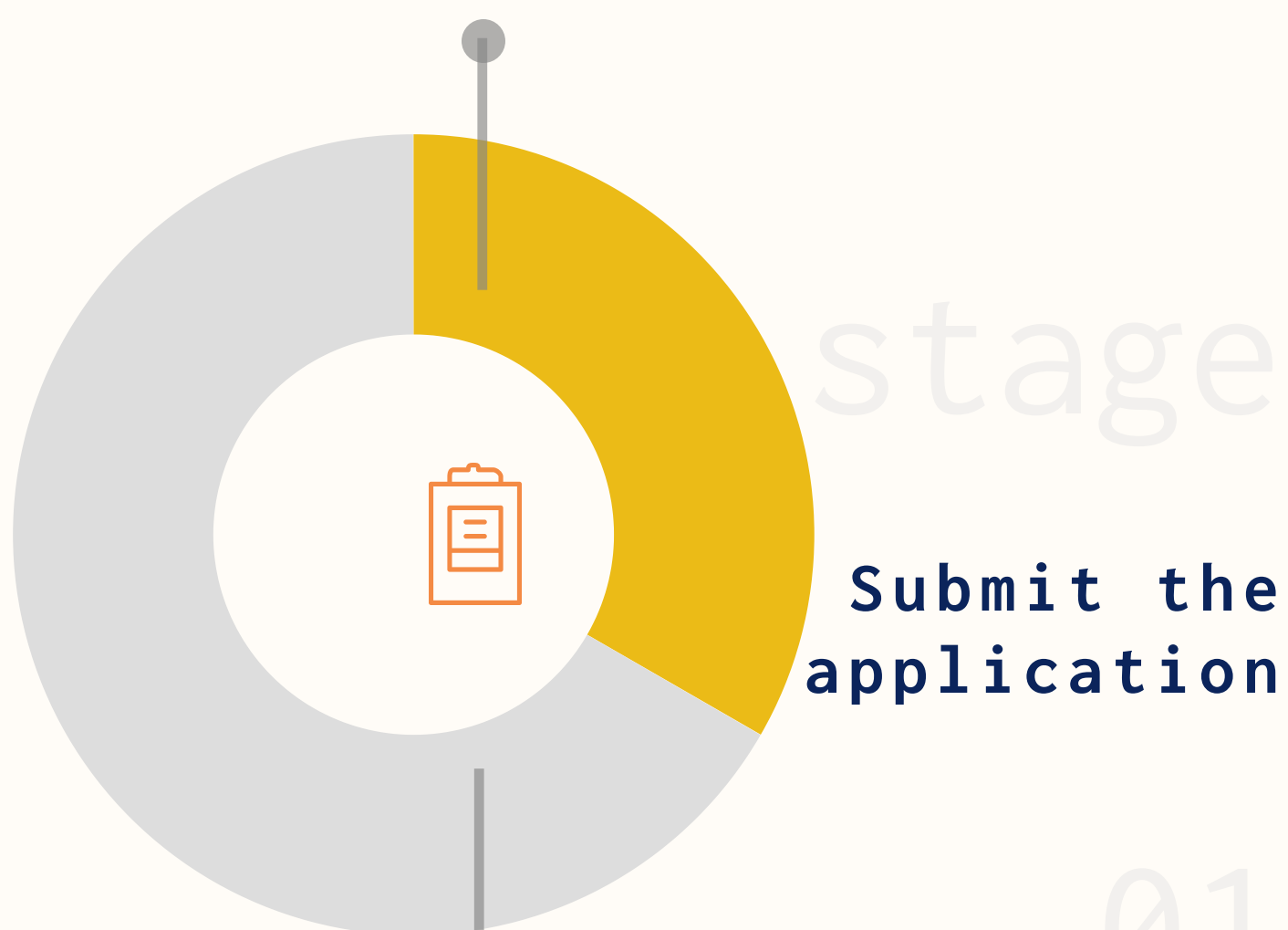


As KyivLEPP participants you will get a practical solution to improve the quality of access to justice in your country / region / community.

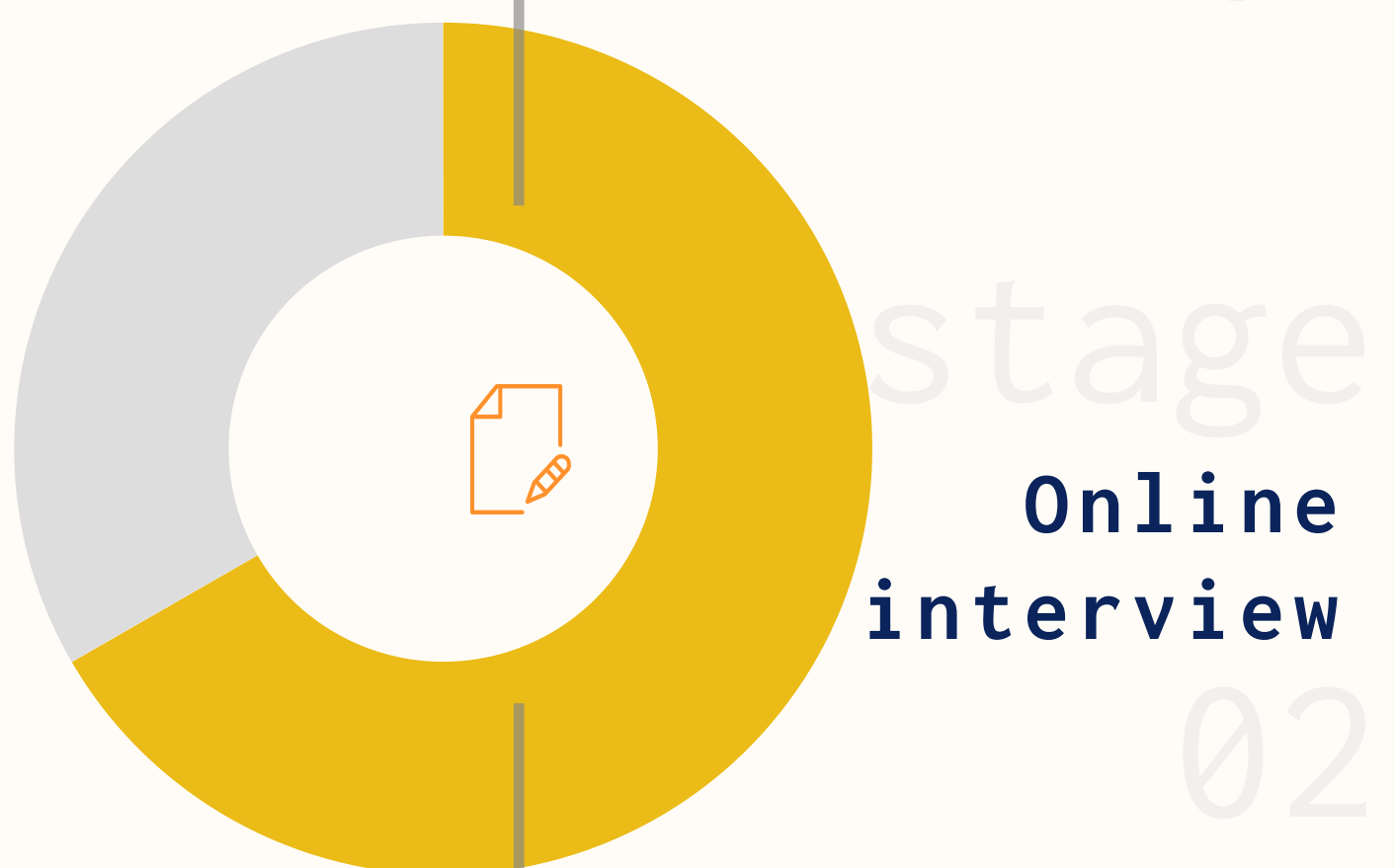


The team that successfully completes KyivLEPP 2020 will receive tech **expert support for the development and implementation** of the solution to the chosen problem

How to participate? The competition to take part in KyivLEPP involves such stages:



You, representing an organization or initiative, submit an intersectoral team of your colleagues. The team should include at least 3 representatives of different sectors in the field of access to justice. We're waiting for team applications **till 18 October**. Please describe your idea and roles of team members in the application.



Before November 6, go through a team video interview in ZOOM with Kyiv LEPP experts. All representatives of your national team should take part in the interview. You will receive detailed instructions on how to pass a video interview, it is easy.



If the interview is successful, the team will be asked to make a short video about their idea by **November 13**. Based on the results, the team will be considered as selected to participate in KyivLEPP 2020.

Till 18 October the team leaders **SUBMIT TEAM'S APPLICATION**

The team chooses a leader who submits the application and will be a contact person with the organizers. **Team members will be registered separately by a personal link** (received via e-mail, which will be specified by the team leader in the team's application)

CRITERIA FOR THE TEAM SELECTION
